REMINDERS

ONLINE REGISTRATION: You need to enroll your student(s) online EVERY school year. If you haven't done so yet, you can find the link on the homepage of our district website at www.bhmsd.org and click on the ENROLL box (listed as an option on the right side of the homepage). If you have any questions regarding this process, please call or come in. We have a computer set up in the office to help with enrollment.

CHROMEBOOKS: Students have received their Chromebooks with a charger and stylus. Replacement stylus & chargers can be purchased in the office throughout the school year for \$30.00 each (cash or checks payable to BHMSD). Chromebook damage fees for breaks or lost or stolen Chromebooks will be assessed and a statement emailed to the first 2 contacts listed in PowerSchool. Students will also receive a paper copy of their statement if damages occur.

SPORTS PHYSICALS: If your child plans to participate in a sport this year, a physical MUST be on file before they can participate in practice. Sports physicals must be done April 1, 2023 or after to qualify for the current school year. Bluffton HS & MS will continue to use Final Forms to house and collect all Pre-Participation Physicals, Tiger Contract, IHSAA requirements and Waivers. Students will only need to turn in a paper copy of the physical form. All required paperwork to participate in Middle School and High School athletics need to be gathered electronically. Physical forms are available at most doctor's offices as well as the school office. We also have a link on our school website, www.bhmsd.org. Click on the menu option at the top right corner. At that point a red bar will show across the top of the page. Click on Extracurricular (do not choose from the drop down menu, just click on Extracurricular). A page with options will show on the screen. Choose IHSAA Physical Form. For questions, please call the high school at 824-3724 and ask for Kelli Kistler in the athletic department. Steps to complete:

- 1. Parents complete information and sign waivers (sign-in or create a new account)
- 2. Students logs in to their school email and signs waivers
- 3. A paper copy of the physical may be needed at the doctor's office (most doctor offices will provide one)
- 4. Physicals are to be turned into the school athletic office after exam or uploaded directly to Final Forms.
- 5. A full set of directions for Final Forms can be found on our website at www.bhmsd.org

BUS POLICY & TRANSPORTATION CHANGES: Students are not permitted to ride a different bus home with a friend. Students are assigned to one bus only w/exceptions considered. (ex: AM rides from home, PM goes to babysitter.) Families are not able to change a student's after school transportation for a short-term solution, other than to change the student's status from a bus rider to a car rider or walker. Parents must communicate with their bus driver prior to the start of the school year. If the driver is not aware that your child will be riding, the student cannot ride the bus. Students are able to ride an alternate bus to the Boys & Girls Club which will not impact their regular bus assignment. Students are not able to eat or drink on the bus. If a transportation change happens during the school day, please call the office or email mstrans@bhmsd.org by 2:30pm. MAKE-UP WORK: It is the responsibility of the student to check with the teacher(s) for make-up assignments. Students are discouraged from taking family vacations during the school year. Students who travel during the school year are responsible for meeting with the teacher prior to the absence. Teachers are NOT expected to have work available for students prior to their vacation time. A teacher email and extension listing is attached to the Week-at-a-Glance posted to Parent Square every Friday.

STUDENT INFO: It is important that we have the most up-to-date contact information for you and your student(s) in case of an emergency. Please call the office throughout the year with any changes in address, phone numbers, email addresses, medical info, bus changes, etc. This goes for you, your student, and their emergency contacts' information.

STUDENT LUNCHES cost \$2.75/day, \$13.75/5 days, \$55.00/20 days. If you qualify for reduced lunches, they are 40¢/day. These prices include one milk, but do NOT include extra items for purchase, such as chips, cookies, and water bottle/juice/extra milk (checks payable to BHMS Lunch – Please write student's name on check). Contact our head cook, April Engle, with any questions about your student's lunch account by calling the office or emailing aengle@bhmsd.org. NOTE FOR FREE OR REDUCED LUNCHES: TRCF (lunch assistance) expires each year, so you will need to apply by October 1 if you believe your income qualifies. Forms are available in the office if your income changes at any point throughout the year.
